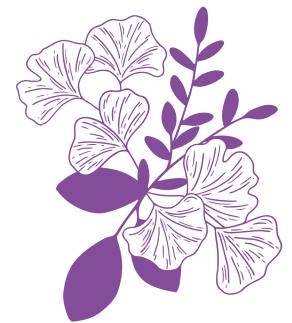


In order for people to experience birth in a way that is nurturing to their inner self, we must release power back to the bodies that are giving birth and provide a safe space to learn and recover in.

About Us

Naturally Nurtured Birth Services began as a solo practice in 2018. It was founded due to increasing health disparities amongst marginalized communities, specifically black birthing people and lack of extensive birth support in Memphis, TN. It has since expanded to a team of compassionate birth workers collectively making a difference..



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We support all types of childbirth and parenting scenarios. This includes natural births, epidurals, cesarean births, multiples, NICU stays, breastfeeding, chestfeeding, induced lactation, bottle feeding, high-risk pregnancies, hospital, birth center and home births.



Emotional

Doulas help families to feel supported, easing the emotional experience of birth and also helping to create a space where physiological birth can take place. Whether a birth is completely unmedicated or medically complex, every family can benefit from the nurturing and compassionate care of a doula.

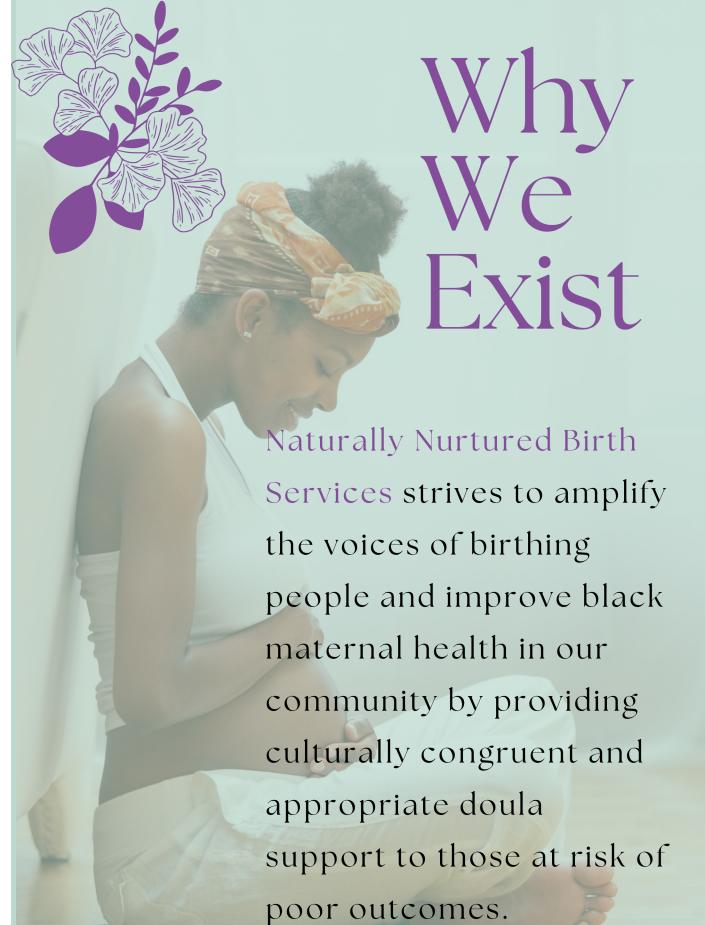
Educational

Our doulas are trained to help families connect with resources so they can ask great questions and make informed decisions about their births. Doulas serve as a bridge of communication between their client and their providers, lifting them up to help them find their voices and advocate for the very best care.

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Physical

A doula's skilled hands and positioning tools can often help a malpositioned baby find its way through the pelvis and into the birthing parent's arms. Providing position ideas for comfort and labor progression with hands-on comfort measures like touch, counter-pressure, breathing techniques and other evidence-based support for families.



Black women are 3-4x more likely to experience a pregnancy related death than white women in America.

Black babes die at 2-3x the rate of white babies before they reach their first birthday.

• There are racial disparities in Tennessee mirroring the national trend. Between 2017-2020, 113 women died from pregnancy-related causes. 89% of these deaths were deemed preventable and highest among black women.

Naturally Nurtured Birth Services is operated by women of color. Our team consists of empathetic and compassionate women who are dedicated to improving maternal health care through support and education.

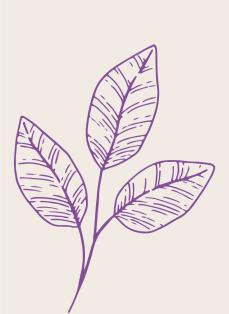
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Locally, there is only one birth center in Memphis, TN and zero doula support centers available to families.

Internationally, less than 5 percent of community birth centers are led by people of color. There are less than 5 doula support centers that exist in total across the United States.

Historically, black birth workers faced competition, criminalization, and exclusion from their practice by physicians who sought to ban them from the profession.

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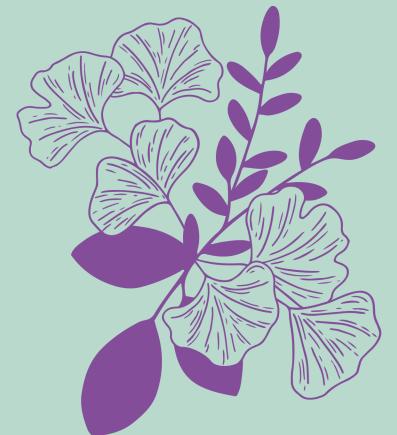




Our Mission

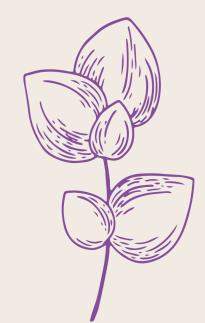

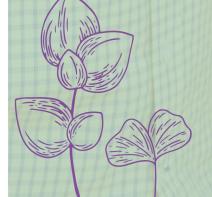
